

Submitting comments on

Your comments must refer to **Docket Number M-2010-2152691**

Deadline for comments is April 1, 2010. Comments can be submitted either on paper (by mail or in person) or electronically through the eFiling system. Although eFiling is not spelled out in the order requesting comments, it is a valid method for submitting comments. The order (paragraph 3) also refers to emailing comments directly to individuals at the PUC. **Emailing (as opposed to eFiling) is not a legal submission of comments** but a convenience for PUC staff who are working on the case to get the comments in a timely manner. Therefore, you should both legally submit comments (via mail, in person, or via electronic filing with eFiling) AND email comments to the individuals referenced in the order for comments (page 6, paragraph 3).

Paper comments should include an original and three copies and are due in the Commission office by 4/1/2010. There will be no confirmation of receipt for comments submitted in this manner but they will be scanned and available for others to view on the website.

Electronically on the Commission's electronic filing system

eFiling permits you to file comments electronically with the Commission without filing paper copies and to receive electronic service of documents from the Commission. When registering to use eFiling, eFilers will be asked to provide information, including their name, the party they represent, their address and their email address if they agree to receive service of documents electronically.

In order to electronically file documents with the Commission, you will first need to create an eFiling user account.

There are two ways to set up an eFiling account: an Individual or Corporate account.

You should set up an Individual account if you are a user that is not part of a corporation/company that has set up a Corporate account. You may be an individual or an employee of an organization that has not established and do not intend to establish a Corporate account.

You should set up a Corporate account if you are a member of a corporation/organization/company that has a need to monitor the filings submitted by all of its members. For example, XYZ Electric Utility may set up a Corporate account and all of the employees that submit eFilings will be sub-accounts under the Corporate account. All of the eFilings made by the sub-accounts will be visible by the owner of the Corporate account. Each sub-account once established by the Corporate account acts as if it is its own individual account and cannot see the eFilings made by other sub-accounts. Only the Corporate account owner can see all of the eFilings made by the sub-accounts.
